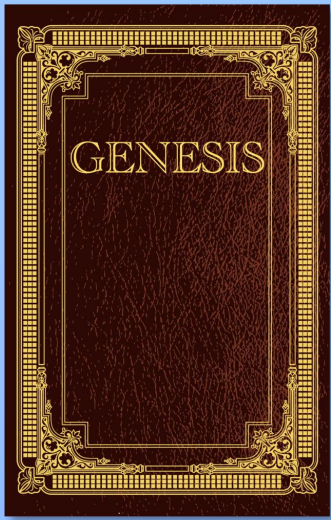
Hebrew *ma-shi-ach* (מָשִׁיחַ)

Titles: The Son of God
