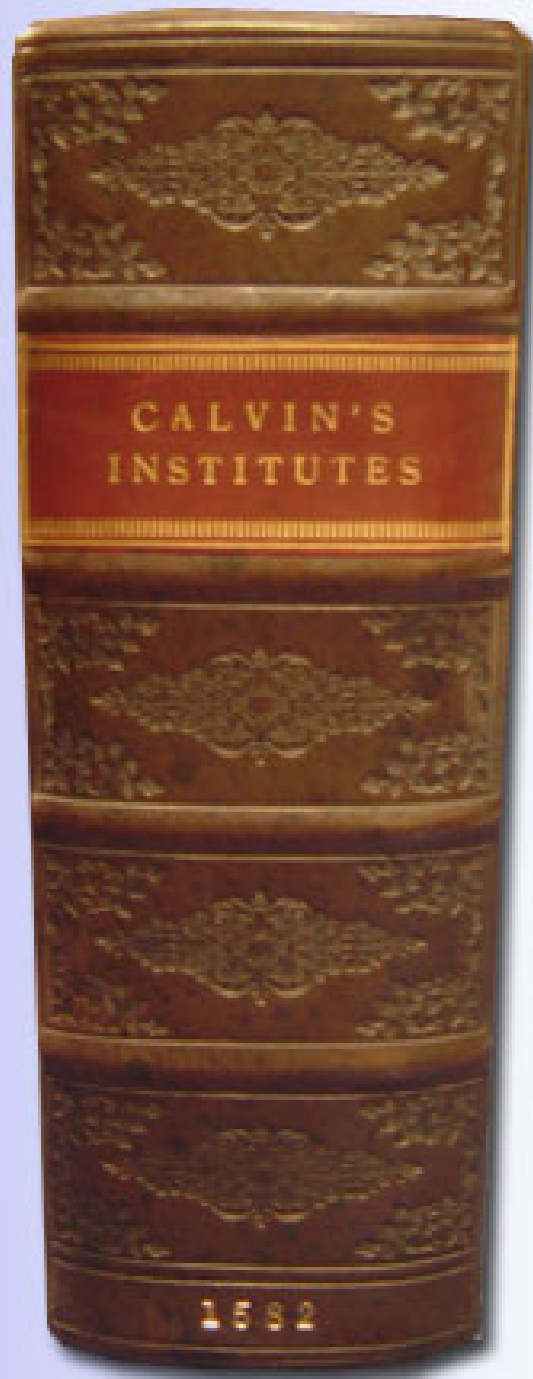
The Church Splinters in the “Holy Roman Empire”
