Paul becomes the central focus.
“When Peter came to Antioch, I
opposed him to his face, because he
was clearly in the wrong. Before
certain men came from James, he
used to eat with the Gentiles

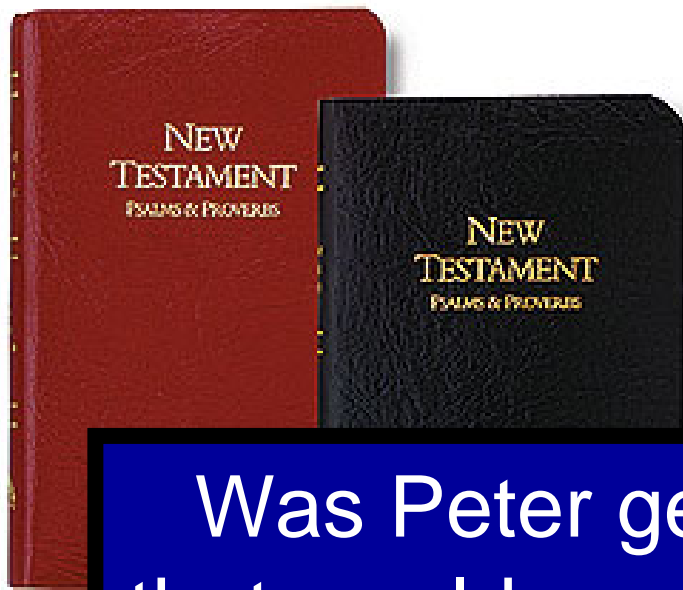


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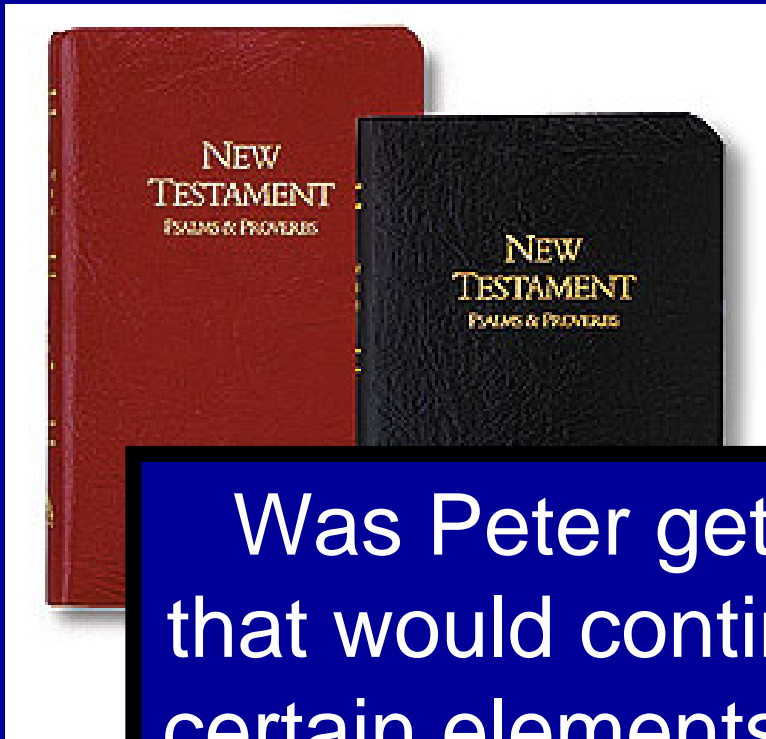

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Points for Home

Points for Home
