First Century A community meal, then "They rise up all together and standing in the middle of the refectory form themselves first into two choirs, one of men and one of women, the leader and presenter chosen for each being the most honored among them and also the most musical. Then they sing hymns to God composed of many measures and set to many melodies, sometimes chanting together, sometimes taking up the harmony antiphonally...Then when each choir has separately done its own part...they mix and become a single choir.
