





"The man who teaches his daughter the Torah teaches her extravagance" (Sota, 3, 4; cf. B. Sota, 21b.)








Jesus gave women a seat in the classroom!








Roles and responsibilities are important


Calling on Jesus to save us, is perfect praise. It is ascribing to Jesus the role only he can do.




Jn. 19:25-27







