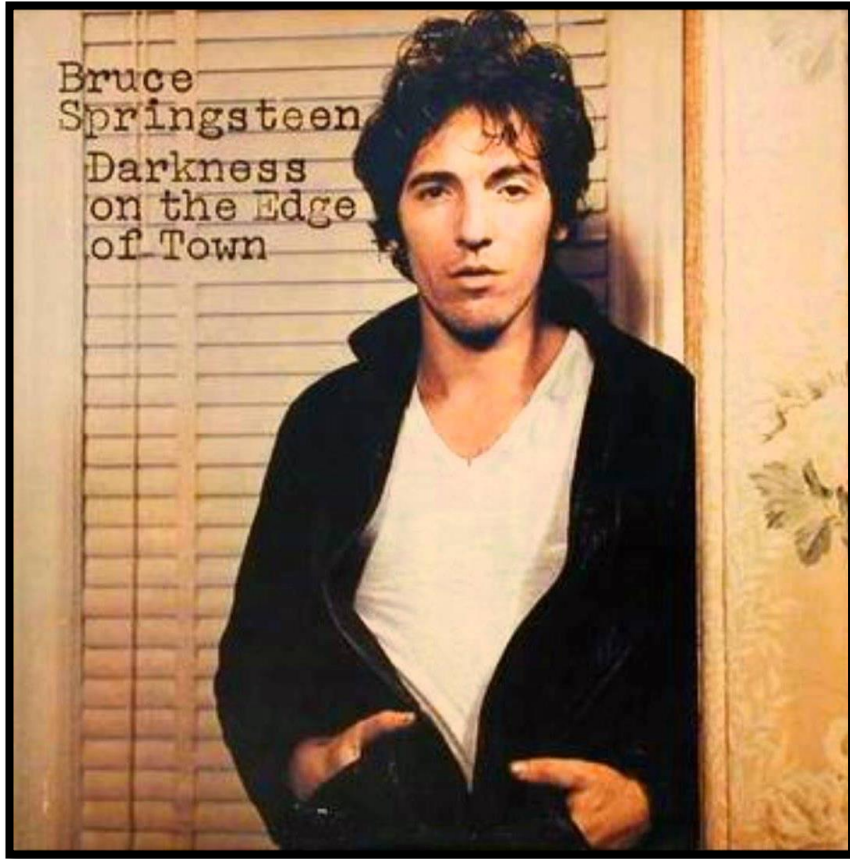


**Don't fear the
