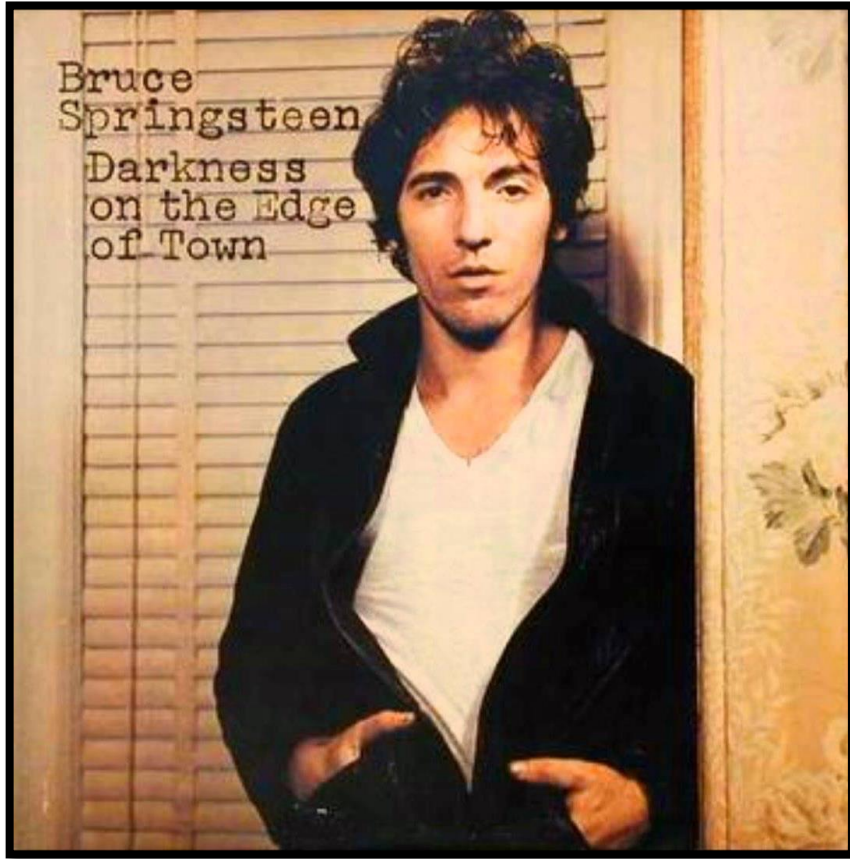
**I have
