Hab. 1:2 O LORD, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not hear? Or cry to you "Violence!" and you will not save?

### God replies



It is acceptable and holy to cry to the God who knows our hurt. We are okay when we bring our sincere heart to God. He will hear our cries, and he *will* answer Then he said to them, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch with me." And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will." (Mt. 26:38-39) And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Mt. 27:46)

### Hab. 1:3-4

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




