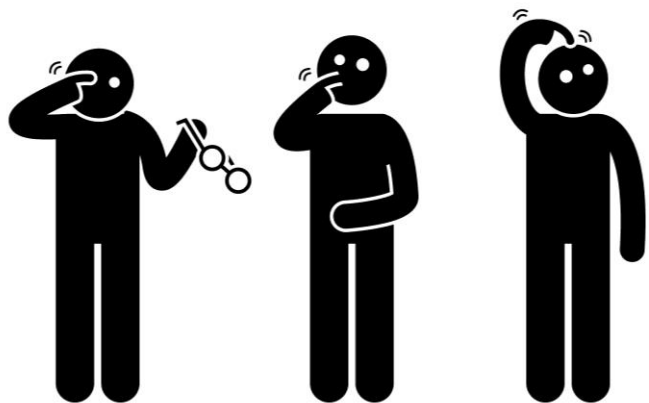

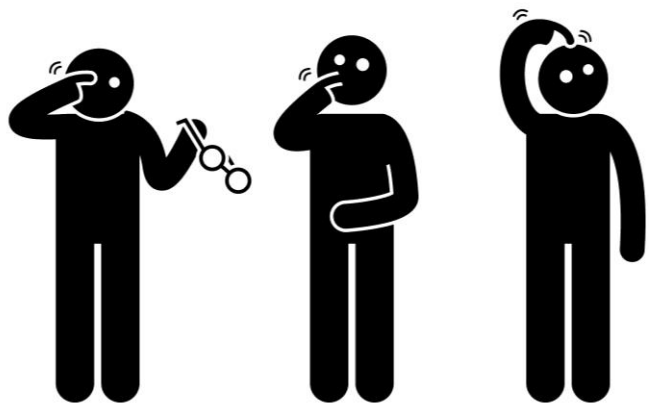

God's Curriculum Vitae

Personal:

- **Traits:** All-loving, holy, true, moral and righteous, omnipotent, omniscient and wise, social, and communicative.
- One God in three persons. A “trinity” or “triune” God in the persons often called “Father,” “Son,” “Holy Spirit.”
- **Address:** Outside the material universe (transcendent), inside the material universe at all places at all times (immanent), inside of this children (indwelling).
- **Progeny:** One unique Son who always existed plus countless adopted children who have entered the family through an established righteousness provided by God.

Professional:

- **Creator:** As creator, God –
 - Created the heavens and earth, forming and filling them with all that is good. (Gen. 1:1 “In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.” Isa. 45:18 “For thus says the LORD, who created the heavens (he is God!), who formed the earth and made it (he established it; he did not create it empty, he formed it to be inhabited!)”)
 - Created light and dark, well-being and calamity. (Isa. 45:7 “I form light and create darkness; I make well-being and create calamity; I am the LORD, who does all these things.”)
 - Creates a new heaven and earth. (Isa. 65:17 “For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth, and the former things shall not be remembered or come into mind.”)
 - Creates newness in the human heart. (Ps. 51:10 “Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.”)
- **Destroyer:** As destroyer, God –
 - Destroyed the world in a flood. (Gen. 6:17 “For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life under heaven. Everything that is on the earth shall die.”)
 - Destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah. (Gen. 19:13 “For we are about to destroy this place, because the outcry against its people has become great before the LORD, and the LORD has sent us to destroy it.”)

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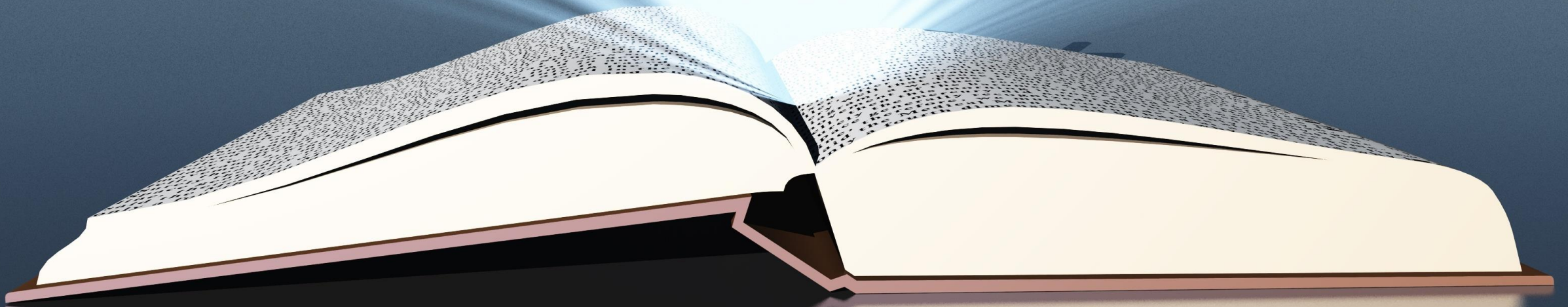
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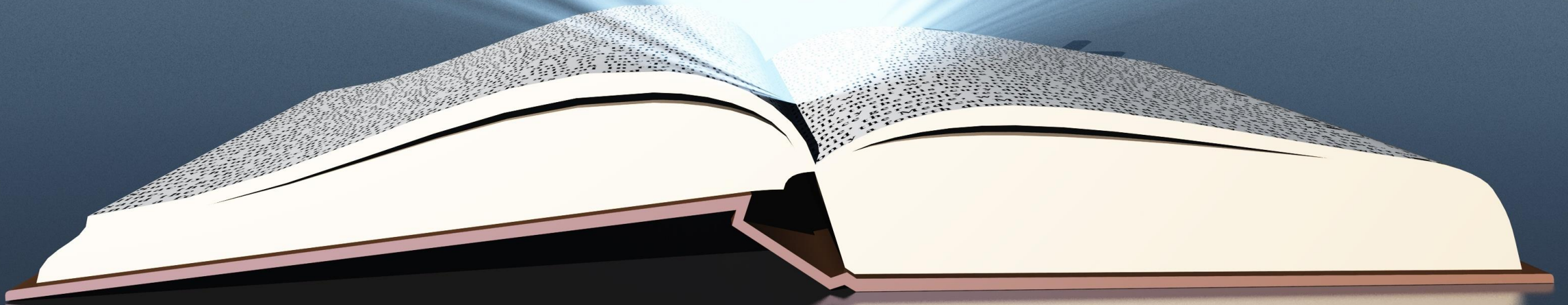
