Gen. 17:10-11

"This is my covenant, which you shall keep, between me and you and your offspring after you: Every male among you shall be circumcised. You shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and you."



But circumcision in the spirit, accomplished most excellently by Zipporah (that is, the church) on the new people (that is, believers in Christ), frightens death even against its will and overturns it while it is raging



Zipporah of old had circumcised her child, and driven off the danger which hung over him; but then Christ...was circumcised first, according to the Law, that He might not break the Law, afterwards by the Cross, that He might fulfil the Law.
