

What About Paul?


The Acts of Paul and Thecla

At length they saw a man coming (namely Paul), of a low stature, bald (or shaved) on the head, crooked thighs, handsome legs, hollow-eyed; had a crooked nose; full of grace; for sometimes he appeared as a man, sometimes he had the countenance of an angel. (1:7)

“The people of Tarsus have devoted themselves so eagerly, not only to philosophy, but also to the whole round of education in general that they have surpassed even Athens or Alexandria”





 - Purchase
 - Birth
- Proof (Diptych)
- Three names
 - Forename
 - Family Name
 - Common Name

- Fair Public Trial
- Exemptions From Certain Punishments
- Protection From Summary Execution
- Rights Paul Used -- Sometimes

Gamaliel

- Historically a Top Rabbi

“When Rabban Gamaliel the Elder died, the glory of the Torah ceased, and purity and holiness died.” Sotah 9:15

Hebrew of Hebrews

Acts 21:39

“I am a Jew from Tarsus in Cilicia, a citizen of no ordinary city.”

Acts 22:3

“I am a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city. Under Gamaliel I was thoroughly trained in the law of our fathers and was just as zealous for God as any of you are today.”

Acts 22:27-28

The commander went to Paul and asked, “Tell me, are you a Roman citizen?” “Yes, I am,” he answered. Then the commander said, “I had to pay a big price for my citizenship.” “But I was born a citizen,” Paul replied.
