- Feast of Booths
- *Sukkot* ("Temporary Booths")
 - -Sukah : Singular
 - -*Sukan* : Dwelling
 - Skn / Shkn

Institution

- Leviticus 23:33-44
- 7 Day / Autumn (15th of Tishri)
 - "You shall live in booths seven days in order that future generations may know that I made the Israelite people live in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt." (Lev. 23:42-43)

Meaning

- Autumn
- Feast of Ingathering (Ex. 23:16b; 39:22)
- Messianic Holiday

• Zechariah 14

The survivors from the nations will "go up year after year to worship the king, Yahweh Almighty, and to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles." (V. 16)
