- Climax of Gospel
- Jesus In Control
 - Not Taken, Gives Self Up
 - Soldiers Taken Aback
 - Stops Peter

The Trial

- Stage One: Jewish
 - Annas (Peter 1x, Charcoal, Challenge/Abuse)
 - Caiaphas (Peter 2x)
- Stage Two: Roman
 - Irony of Jews Staying Out
 - Pilate Detailed In John

The Crucifixion

- One Word
- Gamble For Clothes
- Worry For Mary
- “It Is Finished.”
- Side Pierced
- Joseph / Nicodemus

The Resurrection

- Mary
 - “Do not hold onto me.” (20:17)
- Apostles sans Thomas
- Thomas
- Fishing and the Restoration of Peter
 - 3 Denials, Questions, Affirmations, Charges
 - Love: *Agape* / *Phileo*
- John Will Die
