









I am able to describe the very place in which the blessed Polycarp sat and the accounts which he gave of his intercourse with John and with the others who had seen the Lord. And what he heard from them concerning the Lord, and his miracles and his teaching, having received them from eyewitnesses of the 'Word of life,' Polycarp related all things in harmony with the Scriptures.




