



Pharisees and the Hasidim

In those days there appeared in Israel men who were breakers of the law, and they seduced many people, saying: 'Let us go and make an alliance with the Gentiles all around us.... • The place of stoning is well outside the court




Rules:

- The place of stoning is well outside the court
- At the place of stoning, if the convicted party says, "I have something to say in favor of my own acquittal," the Jews must "bring him back" to the court




Rules:

• When the convicted was ten cubits [about 15 feet] from the place of stoning, they say to him, "Confess." The words are provided in the *Mishna*: May my death be an atonement for all my sins.



Rules:

 They push the convicted from a cliff, drop a stone on his heart, continue until he is buried under stones.
