

### We left Paul in Caesarea, the port 60 miles from Jerusalem






Paul, Luke and others were staying with Philip the evangelist

### The solution? **Show** the rumors to be false with 4 men in need of a haircut!













### Paul went to the Temple, but the results were different than expected!



### Paul was given permission to address the crowd ... he did so in Aramaic




