


Paul was able to go "in and out among them at Jerusalem, preaching boldly in the name of the Lord" (Acts 9:28)

Barnabas goes to Tarsus to find Paul and together they teach "Christians" for a year






Friendship involves time together – it does not just "happen"

Paul "opposed him to his face" for conduct that "was not in step with the gospel" (Gal. 2:14)




Paul gently helps and forgives, continuing to work together


"we all agreed to choose some men and send them to you with our *dear friends* Barnabas and Paul" Friendship is not possessive. Friends are happy when others join the circle.




Does John Mark go on mission trip 2?
