"present"

Stresses the process or action of continual living

Paul explains in detail in 3:4-10

"aorist"

Proper b/c this is neither progressive nor repetitive

"Gain" (*kerdos* - κέρδος) is a bit unusual



# Assonance

the repetition of the sound of a vowel or diphthong in nonrhyming stressed syllables near enough to each other for the echo to be discernible




