



What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound?


We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

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


Our old identity as a slave to sin has been legally and actually terminated. Sin no longer has any business in our lives.

One who has died has been set free from sin (Rom. 6:7)




Learn to use the tools
