



#### John 17


- <sup>14</sup> I have given them Your Word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, ...

"Active support from beneath" = ὑπολαμβάνειν (v) implies offering warmth, shelter, and provisions to guests, particularly those traveling.



## Correct, Rebuke, Restore

Galatians 6:1-2 - "Restore him in gentleness..." 2 Timothy 2:24-26 – "Gently correct opponents" James 5:19-20 - "Bring back a wondering soul" 2 Peter 3:15–Help scriptural misunderstandings Luke 17:3-4 – If your brother sins, rebuke him..." 1 Thessalonians 5:14 – "admonish the idle..." Titus 3:10–11 – "Warn a divisive person..."

### II. Diotrephes

<sup>9</sup> I have written something to the church, but Diotrephes, who likes to put himself first, does not acknowledge our authority. <sup>10</sup> So if I come, I will bring up what he is doing, talking wicked nonsense against us. And not content with that, he refuses to welcome the brothers, and also stops those who want to (welcome...) and puts them out of the church.

#### **Matthew 18**

15 "If your brother sins against you, go and tell **him** his fault, **you and him alone**.

If he listens to you, you've gained your brother.

<sup>16</sup> But if he does not listen, take 1 or 2 others
with you, that every charge may be established
