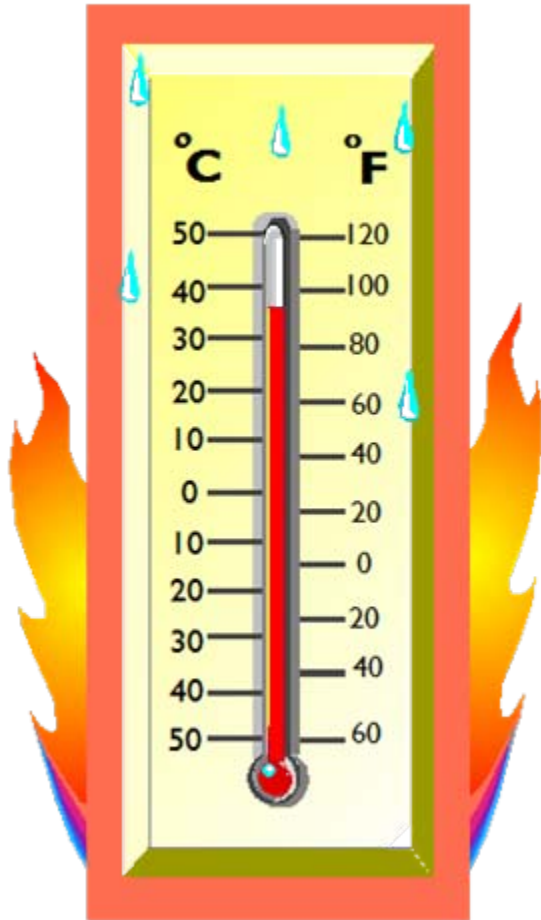
Paul gives James and the elders a full report. There is much rejoicing
