**Rabban Shimon ben Gamliel said:** The ancestral house of my father, the dynasty of *Nesi'im* from the house of Hillel, **was accustomed to give its white clothes to a gentile launderer no fewer than three days before Shabbat. And, however, these, Beit Shammai, and those, Beit Hillel, agree that, *ab initio*, one may load the beam of the olive press on the olives on Shabbat eve while it is still day, so that the oil will continue to be squeezed out of the olives on Shabbat. So too, one may load the circular wine press to accelerate the process of producing wine from the grapes.**

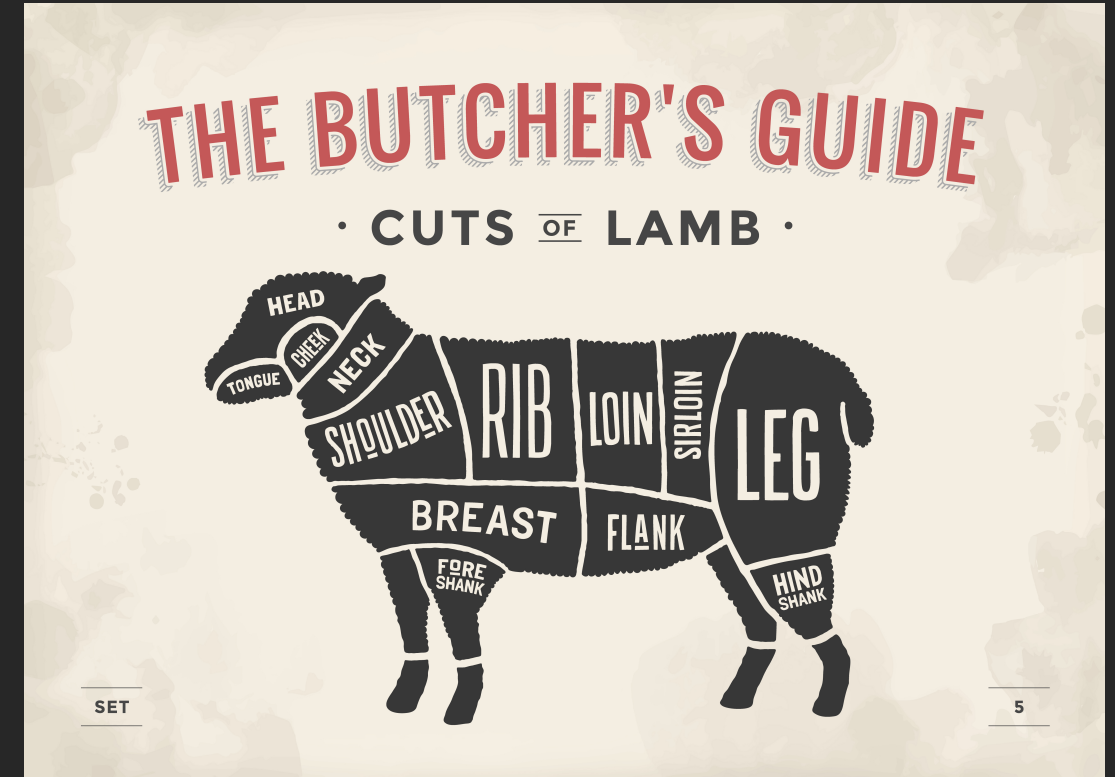
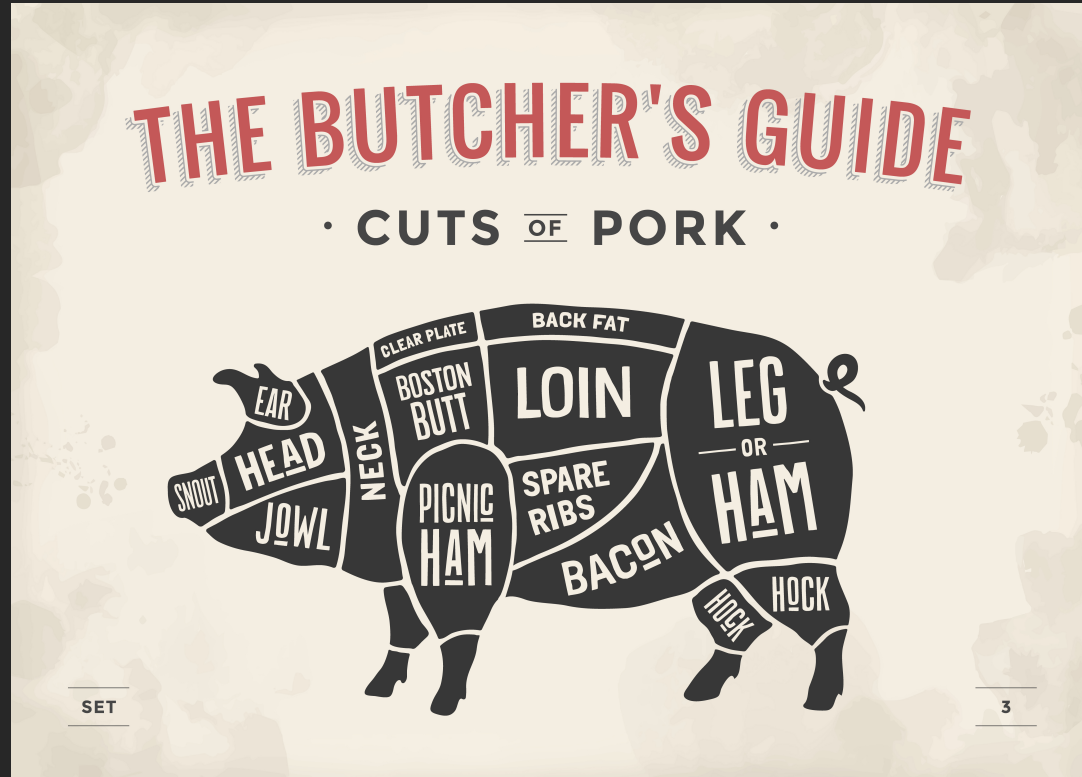

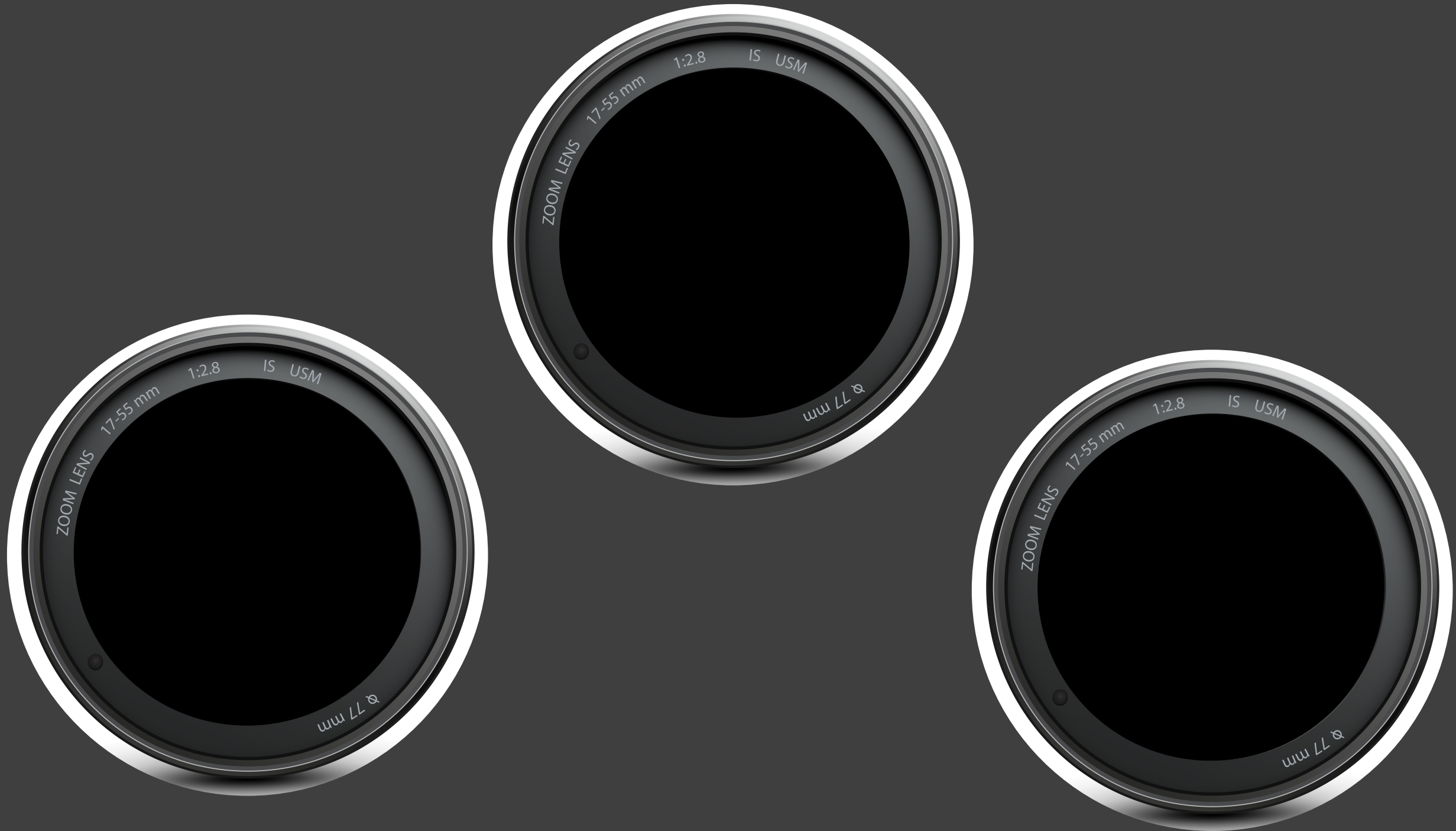
