Oil reserves use debated

Texans in Congress say 'no' to tapping stockpile

WASHINGTON (AP) — Tapping the nation's emergency oil stockpile would do little to rein in soaring heating oil prices, say Texans in Congress who are concerned that such a move by the Clinton administration would set a dangerous precedent and could harm national security.

As heating oil prices have spiked in the Northeast in recent weeks, the administration has come under growing pressure to dip into the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, the 580-million-barrel supply stored in underground salt caverns in Texas and Louisiana.

The administration appears torn about siphoning from the

concerns with the White House in recent weeks.

"This entire episode highlights the fact that we need a national energy policy," Sandlin said. "Right now, all we do is respond to the emergency of the moment. We have no plan, no policy."

Richardson apparently shares the Texans' view that the reserve not be used to manipulate market prices.

"The Strategic Petroleum reserve should be used for national emergencies, for supply emergencies," Richardson said Tuesday on CBS' "Early Show." "We don't want to manipulate prices. We think that oil prices should be determined by the
